

# DEPARTMENT 16 EVERGREEN (Christmas) TREES

Adult Division (A) – all entries in Classes 1 – 9 are classified as adult entries. This is the default division; **no age/grade letters should be added**. Entry codes are in brackets [ ]. Entries in Classes 10-12 may be made by Middle School (M) and High School (H) youth. **All youth entrants must add their age/grade division letter to the end of entry codes on their registration form and entry tags**. Adults should not enter age/grade letters.



6. All trees must have been grown locally by the exhibitors.
7. All wreaths must be a minimum of 14 inches in diameter and may include decorations provided the wreath is at least 75% evergreen. Wire hoops may be used as a foundation. Wreaths may not be sprayed to add artificial color. Spray snow or flocking may be used.

- Class 2 - Pine tree, Red [160102]
- Class 3 - Pine tree, Scotch [160103]
- Class 4 - Pine tree, White [160104]
- Class 5 - Pine tree, Norfolk [160105]
- Class 6 - Spruce tree, Blue [160106]
- Class 7 - Spruce tree, Norway [160107]
- Class 8 - Spruce tree, White [160108]
- Class 9 - Any other evergreen tree not listed [160109]
- Class 10 - Wreath, fresh evergreen  
(Age divisions M, H & A)
  - A. Fir [160110A]
  - B. Pine [160110B]
  - C. Spruce [160110C]
- Class 11 - Garland, fresh evergreen (minimum length five feet) [160111] (Age divisions M, H, & A)
- Class 12 - Any other fresh evergreen decoration [160112] (Age divisions M, H, & A)

A minimum of three feet of evergreen material must be used; may not be wreaths or garlands – may be tabletop decoration, wall hanging, swag, etc.



1. Trees to be exhibited shall be three to six feet in height as measured from the bottom of the handle to the top of the tip.
2. No artificial colors or chemicals may be added to trees by spraying nor in any other manner.
3. No limbs nor foliage may be added to the trees.
4. Trees may be exhibited as they have been grown naturally or they may be sheared and shaped by the exhibitor.
5. Trees may be exhibited live (balled for replanting) or cut (exhibitor shall supply a simple base). Balling or bases shall not be judged.
