

Whatever – Solution

Guess the words defined by clues. The answers vary in length from three to nine letters long and of these, four are capitalized, one is an alternate spelling and one is a foreign word. Punctuation in the clues may or may not help the solver.

Enter the answers in the grid one after the other starting in the top left corner and in the same order as the clues. Across words that don't end at the rightmost square of the row will continue on the leftmost square of the next row. Similarly, down words that do not end in the bottom square will continue at the top of the next column.

For seven across words and six down words, one of the letters will need to be removed before the answer is entered into the grid. These thirteen letters, taken in order, will spell out a word that describes how I came up with the four unclued mystery entries.
