And, for those of you who prefer to pay tuition and lunch bunch/stay & play in cash, please know we do not keep cash for change in the office. We also accept credit cards in the office for all transactions Thank You for your help.

#### Snack Notes

When it is your turn to provide snack for the class, a half gallon of drink is enough for the entire class. We highly recommend water be served and that you avoid sending any drink that is in prepackaged individual containers. One of the skills children practice at preschool is successfully pouring from a pitcher into a cup.

#### Volunteers

We love having your help at our school. However, due to California State regulations that govern our program, we cannot allow siblings to stay in the room while you assist as it affects our teacher/child ratio. If you want to help in the room, we ask that you find childcare for you other children.

# Developmental Testing

Every year CUMC Preschool offers Developmental Screenings through Chancey and Bruce. This year's testing will take place on Nov. 3rd and 4th. This is a great tool for finding out where your child is developmentally and is especially helpful if you have any concerns or want to identify areas that might need a little extra attention. If you have any questions about this assessment, please speak to your child's teacher or Vicki in the office. Thank you.

### Halloween

This holiday can be enjoyable for children. It can also be frightening and overstimulating. At preschool, we emphasize the fun and some of the traditions of the holiday. We ask that you please do not send your child to school in a costume or mask. Costumes are a favorite dress-up at Preschool. Also, we would appreciate it if no party favors, balloons or gift bags were sent to be distributed in the classroom.

# Making Friends

Social interaction is an important part of development for young children. They are not born knowing how to maintain relationships with people over time or how to resolve conflicts constructively. These social skills are learned by observing how peers and family members respond to different situations and by experimenting and experiencing the consequences of their actions.

Many children at this age are just becoming aware of other children. They may be shy and watch from the sidelines, while others put a great effort into making friends. You can help by being supportive as your child tries to establish friendships. We encourage you to ask your child about his/her friends and give the opportunity to interact with other children outside the classroom. Use your classroom roster and plan a play date or meet them at the park.

<u>Parent Handbook</u> - If you did not get a parent handbook (full-page pamphlet) at registration, please stop by the office and pick one up.

<u>Tile Wall</u> - Our tile wall by the front door is a "growing" wall. If you are interested in having your family or child make a tile, please see Vicki for details.

<u>Coffee and Connections</u> - For families at school on Wednesday, we are offering time to have a cup of coffee and make connections with other preschool parents. The nursery will be open providing a place for your younger children to play while you chat.

<u>Holiday Collections</u> - In November we will be collecting Turkeys and Food for Thanksgiving Baskets given by the CUMC Food Closet. In December we will be collecting new and unwrapped toys for Olive Crest. This organization takes in children for foster care/adoption.

<u>Lunch Bunch/Stay and Play</u> - If you want your child to stay for Lunch Bunch, Stay and Play or Enrichment, you <u>MUST</u> sign-up in the office. Wednesdays are getting to be a very popular day so sign up ahead of time, if you can.

### Friendly - and IMPORTANT - Reminders

#### FYI - Car Seats!

As of Jan. 1st, 2017 children under 2 must be in a rear facing car seat <u>UNLESS</u> they are 40 or more pounds or 40 or more inches tall.

#### **Change of Clothes**

Accidents happen.

Please send a change of clothes (shorts, t-shirt and underwear) in your child's bucket each day. Please label all jackets and clothing.

#### Phone Numbers

We ask that when you leave an emergency phone number where you can be reached that you make every effort to have your phone close by while your child is at school.
