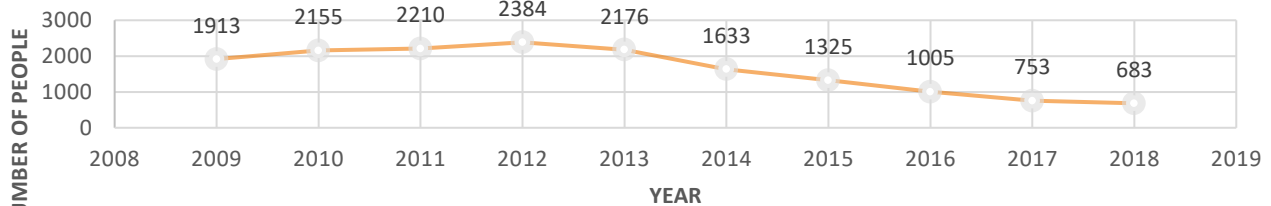

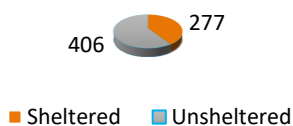

Where did you live when you became homeless?

63.9% from the Flagler-Volusia Area
19.6% from elsewhere in Florida
16.5% from out of state

Top 3 places survey participants reported sleeping at night

Woods/Camp: **40%**
Downtown Streets: **12.6%**
Emergency Shelter: **11.6%**

Top 3 Needs Identified

Affordable Housing: **54.1%**
Shelter: **53.6%**
Food/Meals: **47.3%**
