THE PANCAKE TOWN

Glenn's designation as "The Pancake Town" began when a blizzard gripped the entire northeastern section of the United States on December 7, 1937, in one of the nation's worst snowstorms. Motorists were forced to find shelter wherever they could. In the wake of the storm, more than two hundred motorists were marooned in the small community of Glenn. Residents found that feeding that many people quickly led to a dwindling supply of groceries. However, everyone had the necessary ingredients to prepare pancakes. The golden griddlecakes became a staple for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Soon after, travelers came from all over the United States asking about the pancakes in Glenn. Within a month, the residents were busy making plans for a festival to commemorate the "Storm of 1937". In addition to a Pancake Queen, there were carnival rides, exhibits, games, and a pancake breakfast. Today, you can still enjoy the pancakes at one of three pancake breakfasts held during the summer on a Sunday morning. Please see the schedule of events for 2023 dates.

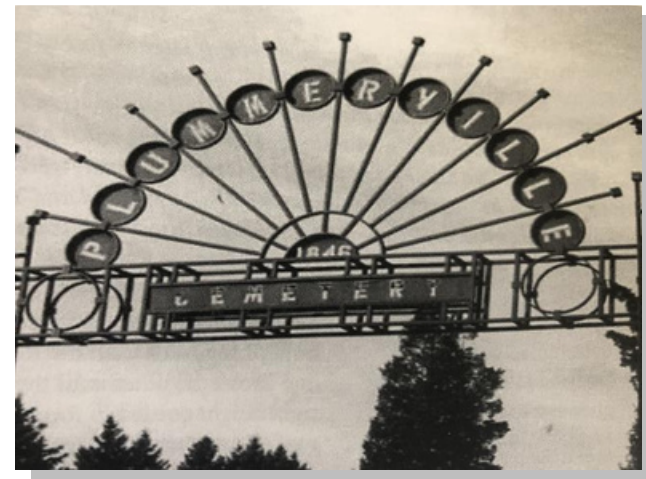
