ON-LINE AND MAIL-IN FEES

\$25 Registration Fee + \$10 Sport Fee per event if registering on or before December 15.
\$30 Registration Fee + \$10 Sport Fee per event if registering December 16 thru February 22.
Paper registration is available but will incur a \$5. Data Entry fee and must be postmarked by Dec. 15.
Registration fee is charged one time only per person.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

February 22, 2018 for all registration.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. Competitors must furnish their own equipment.
2. Competition is in five-year age groups: 50-54, 55-59 etc.
3. A sole competitor in an event will compete in the next younger age group
4. No on-site registrations will be accepted.
4. Awards are by age. Age is determined as of 12/31/2018

FORMAT

The "900" American round will be used for all competition.
90 arrows will be shot as follows:
30 arrows from 60 yards (5 ends of 6 arrows)
30 arrows from 50 yards (5 ends of 6 arrows)
30 arrows from 40 yards (5 ends of 6 arrows)

SPORT RULES

1. All archery events will be conducted in accordance with NAA/NFAA/NSGA Rules except as modified herein.

2. "X" hits will be kept on the scorecard by all competitors and will be used as a tiebreaker.
3. Should equipment failure occur, a 30 minute repair time will be allowed with no disruption of the shooting line. A maximum of 2 ends may be made up at the discretion of the Commissioner.
4. Field glasses or scopes are permitted for spotting arrow hits. Scopes may be placed on the shooting line provided they do not disrupt the shooting of the adjacent archers. Scopes shall be removed from the line between ends if not utilized by the other archer shooting in that space.

5. No broad heads will be permitted.
6. Regulation FITA 122cm (48") five-color target face will be used. Scoring values: Gold (10-9), Red (8-7), Blue (6-5), Black (4-3) White (2-1) 10 ring scoring.
7. Dividing lines are part of the higher scoring. The arrow shaft must only touch the dividing lines between scoring zones to score the high value.
8. Winner shall be the archer(s) scoring the highest number of points in each division and age group.
