
Speaking of Allan.....






# **RAE & Memorial Cruise**



#### WANTED: CAPTAIN for 'ONTARIO CARAVAN 2024'



In August of 2024, the National Corvette Museum (NCM) will celebrate the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of its opening! The NCM has grown over the years and currently boasts a representative collection of every Corvette built. Nowhere else will you see the *only surviving 1983 Corvette!*!

To celebrate this special anniversary occasion, Ontario Corvette owners are invited to participate in a Caravan - often referred to as the world's largest moving automotive event - traveling together to the home of the Corvette. Bowling Green, Kentucky is the destination, arriving in time for the museum festivities to begin. <u>The dates are Thursday</u>, <u>August 29 through Saturday</u>, <u>August 31, 2024</u>.

In order to arrive in Bowling Green together, Ontario needs a Caravan Captain to lead us! An event such as this requires planning and coordinating. Will that be you and your team?

The Caravan Captain must be a National Corvette Museum member. If you're not already an NCM member, signing up is easy. Log on to the NCM website at <u>www.corvettemuseum.org</u>, select 'membership' from the dropdown box, select '**Become a Member**' and follow the steps.

Task highlights to be carried out by the Caravan Captain and the ON organizing team are:


- Choose an organizing committee treasurer, co-captain, and others as required (such as regional representatives, ON Caravan shirts, media, sponsorship coordinators)
- o Have the treasurer set up dual signatory bank accounts in both Canadian and US funds.
- Set up a specific ON Caravan email account and ON Caravan Facebook page
- Sign a contract to reserve hotel accommodation in Bowling Green KY for at least 50 rooms. Request complementary accommodation for the ON Captain in return for the large number of rooms being booked.
- Organize the route from ON to Bowling Green, deciding where best to cross the border. (Note: Unless the captain is familiar with the choice of routes from Ontario to Bowling Green, it is helpful to drive the route and take note of the possible overnight stops along the way.)
- Sign a contract to reserve hotels for the overnight stops on the route to Bowling Green. Request complementary rooms for the ON Captain in return for the large number of rooms being booked.
- Compose and manage the ON webpage for the NCM website including local contact data, ON registration sheet with payment method and amount (~\$25/car) and submit to NCM for posting. Send updates to the Museum as necessary.
- o Post the above information on the ON Caravan Facebook page. Update as required.
- Attend twice-yearly 'Caravan Captains' meetings at the NCM if able, or send an alternate to represent the ON Caravan team.
- Participate in NCM Caravan fund-raising efforts by purchasing items for re-sale to ON Corvette drivers - window clings, flags etc.
- Choose a convenient departure point from ON which has parking and washrooms for all ON Caravan participants
- o Other tasks to be completed or delegated as / when required.
















## **Fall Cruise - Picton**
