Satan wants to depict the world and us (both God's creations) as ugly, violent, meaningless and most important to him, hateful of God and each other. This of course is a LIE. God, who is all beauty and kindness works through us if we allow Him and ask Him to do so. Many people will only meet God in our kind acts. The light of Christ will be attractive to those who want to respond to and be with beauty and kindness. Let us be about spreading beauty and kindness to all we meet. Let us be an instrument of TRUTH in the world: the truth that the Kingdom of God is at hand. It is right here, right now, in the midst of the muck and the mire and the lies of Satan.
