**FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT
 FROM THE JULY 18 MEETING**

- The FY 2021/2022 budget was officially closed and submitted with the closing papers to the Diocese. The new budget was also submitted to the Diocese for approval.
- The committee approved the FY 2022/2023 budget.
- An accounting summary for 2021/2022 will soon be published in the bulletin for everyone to review.
- Maintenance Projects coming up and in progress include interior painting of the church and also hiring an electrician to check exterior lighting, primarily on the east and south sides of the building and replacing any faulty circuits, wiring and units.
- Saint Paul Catholic Center has long last received the building permit from the City of Hurricane to construct the new steel “sorting and storage” building.
- We are currently in the process of obtaining quotes for concrete, HVAC, electrical, water and sewage.
 Once a concrete quote is approved and delivery scheduled, two of the existing metal cargo containers, currently being used for storage will sold and removed. The sale will help defray cost of the new construction.

**THE OLDEST KNOWN PRAYER TO THE
 VIRGIN MARY**

We fly to Thy protection, O Holy Mother of God. Do not despise our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O Glorious and Blessed Virgin

The oldest known Marian prayer is found on an ancient Egyptian papyrus dating from around the year 250. Today known in the Church as the Sub tuum praesidium, the prayer is believed to have been part of the Coptic Vespers liturgy during the Christmas season.

The original prayer was written in Greek and according to Roseanne Sullivan, “The prayer is addressed to Our Lady using the Greek word Θεοτόκος (God-bearer) and is more properly translated as ‘she whose offspring is God.’” This helps to prove that the early Christians were already familiar with the word “Theotokos” well before the Third Ecumenical Council at Ephesus ratified its usage.
