## 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Dance Dress Code

#### LADIES DO'S

Ladies are expected to wear a conservative party dress, either semi-formal or formal dress, and dress shoes.

- Wear clothes that are right for the occasion.
- Always try to be neat. When you are invited to an event, the invitation will tell you what kind of occasion. If you are not sure, call the hostess and ask.
- Wear a dress that is free flowing, not tight.

# The attire below is appropriate for middle school dances.

### LADIES DON'Ts

Ladies may not wear certain attire, including what is considered a "club" dress. The specifics not allowed:

- a. Ladies may not wear a dress that:
  - has a bare midriff
  - is short and/or tight
  - has a neckline that is too revealing
  - is low-cut in the back (no lower than bra line)
- has any cutouts in the material below
  the chest level/bra line
- b. Dress hemlines MUST extend beyond one's fingertips, *including while dancing*.

# The attire below is **not** appropriate for middle school dances.





### 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Dance Dress Code

#### **GENTLEMAN DO'S**

Young men are expected to wear a conservative outfit, either semi-formal or formal outfit, ties (optional) and dress shoes.

- Wear clothes that are right for the occasion.
- Always try to be neat. When you are invited to an event, the invitation will tell you what kind of occasion. If you are not sure, call the hostess and ask.
  - A collared shirt
  - Dress pants/slacks

# The attire below is appropriate for middle school dances.





### **GENTLEMAN DON'Ts**

Gentleman may not wear certain attire. The specifics of what is not allowed:

- a. Young men may not wear a shirt that:
  - Does not have collar
  - Is a shirt with print/logos
  - is ripped or has holes
  - b. No hats or hooded jackets

c. No jeans or pants with holes in them

d. no shorts, sweat pants, or athletic wear

# The attire below is **not** appropriate for middle school dances.
