Mary H. Osantowski, 87, of Ubly died Friday, Dec. 8, 2000, in the Huron County Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe. Mary was born on June 24, 1903, in Tyre, the daughter of the late John and Frances (Lautner) Sadro. She married Frank Osantowski on Sept. 11, 1923, at St. Ignatius Church in Freiburg.
