Thank you for your interest in the Horicon Rod & Gun Club and inquiring on becoming part of our growing family.

Memberships:

Our annual memberships run from January 1st to December 31st of each year. This includes the use of the club property as well as the rifle/pistol range (see club/range rules). We also offer rentals of the club building for members, at a reduced rate. Hunting of any kind or shooting outside of designated areas is not allowed. A single annual membership is \$60.00, a family annual membership is \$80.00, and a lifetime membership is \$300.00. A single membership allows the named member, and only the named member, to use the benefits of the club. A family membership allows the named member, significant other, and children of each UNDER the age of eighteen, to use the benefits of the club. A family membership doesn't include children over eighteen. A lifetime membership allows the named member, and children of that lifetime member UNDER the age of eighteen, to use the benefits of the club. A lifetime membership doesn't include the spouse of or children over eighteen of that named lifetime member. You must be an annual member for 2 years before you are eligible to become a lifetime member. You must obtain and complete a membership application and return it signed to one of the club's monthly meetings OR to a summer trap league night. The summer trap league is Wednesday night and runs from the first Wednesday in May thru the last Wednesday in August and starts around 7pm. We require this of members so we can put a face with the name for safety reasons. Once the completed application and payment have been received thru one of these means, you will receive the current gate lock code as well as a valid membership card. Annual memberships will only be accepted Jan. 1st thru Sept. 1st. No new annual memberships will be accepted after September 1st.

Meetings:

Our monthly meetings are held at the clubhouse the first Thursday of the month at 7 pm January thru September. We do not hold monthly meetings October thru December. As stated above, you must obtain and complete a membership application and return it signed to one of the club's monthly meetings or to a summer trap league night to become a member of the club.

Additional Info:

The rifle & pistol range is open from January 1st thru the day prior to the Wisconsin gun deer season regardless of the date. It is closed the remaining part of the year (End of November & December).

We require each member to volunteer at least once during our yearly events. Please see our website or Facebook for a list of annual events that you can volunteer to be part of. HORICON ROD & GUN CLUB RIFLE RANGE RULES (Revision Date 1/1/2025)

- 1. You must have a current Horicon Rod & Gun Club membership to use the property and shooting range. Members under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult or senior member.
- 2. The rifle/pistol range is open from January 1st thru the day before the Wisconsin gun deer season and only when a designated range manager is at the range. The range is closed during the end of November and all of December for safety reasons.
- 3. ALL shooters must fill out, print name (legible), & sign the daily sign-in sheet and agree to all the range rules & regulations. This sign-in makes you the range manager and allows you to over-see the range and its rules. The sign-in sheet is located in the storage box near the range.
- 4. The red flag MUST be raised on the pole when the range is in use (pistol or rifle).
- 5. All range rules will be employed by the range manager and his directives will be strictly adhered to and enforced. Any violation of this will result in immediate removal from the grounds.
- 6. Maximum caliber is .45 caliber center-fire arms. Muzzle loaders are permitted on the rifle lanes.
- 7. No armor piercing bullets are allowed on the pistol or rifle range.
- 8. No fully automatic firearms are allowed & no multiple shot strings will be tolerated.
- 9. Pin targets on mesh plastic fences only & shoot only paper targets.
- 10. Ear and eye protection must be worn by everyone on the range. HRGC will not be responsible for any injuries resulting from the failure to wear appropriate protection at the range or on the grounds.
- 11. Pick up ALL targets and casings when finished shooting and deposit in the trash container.
- 12. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the range at any time.
- 13. All junior members using the club range must be accompanied by an adult or senior member.
- 14. Weapons on the firing line that are not in use must be unloaded, action open, in a gun rack, or encased.

- 15. Shoot at only targets directly in front of your bench. NO CROSS FIRING PERMITTED and no prone shooting.
- 16. No one is permitted in front of the firing line, except while checking targets and only after a CEASE FIRE has been called by the range manager.
- 17. No handling of weapons is permitted during a CEASE FIRE and actions are to be opened.
- 18. When all firing points (lanes) are in use and others are waiting to fire, a half hour time limit will be observed.
- 19. Anyone who observes an unsafe condition or practice on the range is authorized to call a CEASE FIRE.
- 20. Shot guns, handguns, muzzle loaders and .22 caliber rifles are limited to 50- and 100-yard targets.
- 21. The (2) pistol lanes farthest to the West are limited to pistols only. No rifles or shotguns of any kind will be shot on the pistol lanes.
- 22. The pistol & rifle range is closed when the club house is rented or in use for private events.
- 23. Immediately call the Dodge County Sheriff to report any injuries, malicious acts, or unsafe actions (920-386-3726 or 911)
- 24. Members must have proof of membership present while using the pistol & rifle range as well as the club grounds.
- 25. Non-compliant members will be subject to disciplinary actions by the board of directors and possible removal from the club.
- 26. Hunting of any kind on the club grounds is prohibited and shooting outside of designated areas is not allowed.
