Al became interested in fossils around the age of 10-12 in New York/New Jersey area where he grew up. He began collecting rocks around streams and in the wooded areas after spending time at the local museum. He brought fish fossils (400 million years old), petrified wood (100 million years old), geodes (10 million years old), sharks teeth (100 million years old), shells/nautilus (110 million years old), and Dinosaur bone fragments to share.
