DESCRIPTION: While the BP Colt was a budget conscious bow, it had a reputation as a great looking and performing recurve. I shot a BP Colt as my hunting bow in high school. This Colt is a nice one, a little heavier (mass weight) than most BP Colts. Forest green face limbs and crimson back limbs. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. One short superficial stress line on the lower-back limb riser-fade out, and one longer superficial stress line on the lower limb face limb in the riser fade-out. Neither stress line extends into the working area of the bow (see pics last 2 pages) No crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in excellent condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
