Sermon Series:

All In The Family

What must it have been like to walk with Jesus during his ministry? I find myself thinking about this a lot. We often forget that the disciples were much younger than we depicted them. They were teenagers, most likely. The first youth group! But over the course of a couple years, Jesus, the disciples, and many of his followers became a traveling family. They did everything together. They ate, they worked, they traveled, and formed deep bonds as brothers and sisters in Christ.

In many ways, this becomes the model for the early church. In Acts 2 the church is described liked this:

"Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, 47 praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved." – Acts 2:46-47

For Lent this year we will continue our new tradition of community events to mark the journey to Jesus' death and resurrection, just like the disciples did. We'll gather for food, we'll play games, we'll have fun together, we'll make things together, we'll talk, laugh, and share. This is how the church lives in discipleship. By not just being "friendly" on Sunday morning, but becoming the Family of God.

Family takes care of each other differently then just friends or associates. Family means loving people even when they don't feel very worthy of love, family means having difficult conversations, family means that even when we disagree we care for each other deeply.

Trinity is often described as a family church. Usually that means we have several large interconnected families. But how much better will we be when people describe Trinity as a family church because everyone who enters here is treated like they are part of the same large family.



Bethany House is a long-term shelter in Northwest Ohio for victims and their children who are escaping domestic violence. Many survivors are onsite for more than a year. Bethany House provides the services, tools and resources survivors need to rebuild their lives. All free of charge.

Since 1984, Bethany House has served more than 2,000 individuals and provided more than 300,000 nights of safe shelter for victims and their children escaping domestic abuse in our area. Annually, they serve an average of 30 families.

Bethany House is a sponsored ministry of the Sisters of St. Francis of Sylvania, Ohio and a member of Sylvania Franciscan Ministries and Northwest Ohio Community Shares.




Guidelines for Weather Cancellations at Trinity

Ottawa County Level 1:


Worship and church activities will be held as usual - please use common sense and precaution when traveling.


