

# ALGER PAUL STOECKLE

1920 - 1979

Alger P. Stoeckle, age 59 of Sebewaing, passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, Dec. 18 at Bay Medical Center, Bay City.

He was born Jan. 14, 1920 in Sebewaing Township to the late John and Eleanor Binder Stoeckle. On July 25, 1942 he was united in marriage to Florabell J. Hornbacher in California. He was the owner of Culligan Water & Conditioning Co. in Sebewaing for 34 years.
