Every meaningful journey offers the challenge to persist, accept each increment of progress as it is gained, and appreciate the experience of each step as it is taken. become a positive role model in the LGBT community. A panel of 3 volunteers will read all essays received and vote to decide the winning entry.

In future years, the Noho Pride committee plans to increase the award amount as well as the scope of the scholarship to include students already attending college, as well as nontraditional students returning to college as adults. Each year, the scholarship application will be posted on the Noho Pride website as well as with popular scholarship search engines.


