JACK'S CORNER



“RESPONSIBILITY REQUIRES RESPONSE-ABILITY”

Hopefully most of us have matured into responsible adults. As adults, we want to teach this all-important trait to our children.

Oftentimes we hear statements like, “He/she is not fulfilling their responsibilities at work”, “He/she is not fulfilling their responsibility as a parent”, or “He/she is so irresponsible!”

It should be understood, that when one is given a job description, and the details of what that job description entails, the person who has acquired the job is expected to carry out these stipulations.

As shown in the above title, responsibility requires RESPONSE on the part of individuals placed in various jobs, or roles. RESPONSE obviously requires action.

Not only in the secular world, but also in the church, we as Christians have responsibilities. Elders and deacons are given certain responsibilities from the scriptures (I Tim. 2:1-13; Titus 1:5-9). Elders hand down responsibilities to the ministers and give specific jobs to deacons.

Hopefully, these in various offices of the church have a proper attitude and are willing to respond in a positive way as to fulfill their obligations.

This doesn't mean that those who are often referred to as “regular” church members do not have responsibilities.

ALL church members can RESPOND by (1) Not procrastinating—If one sees a need, they should not hesitate to implement steps to take care of that need, (2) Being organized—Activities of the church will be carried out much more smoothly when one has a plan in place, and (3) Working the plan—When church members RESPOND willingly it isn't difficult for a work to be completed.

Whatever our role in the church, may we be zealous in achieving our responsibilities for the good of the church (Ecc. 9::10).

Someone has said, “*The starting point of achievement is desire.*”
