Ordinance O-2018-17

AN ORDINANCE HIRING JENNIFER DIESEL-SLOAN AS A FULL TIME MAYOR'S COURT/POLICE CLERK FOR AMELIA VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Council of Amelia Village made the decision to change the position of Mayor's Court Clerk as a part time position to a full time position of Assistant to the Chief of Police/Mayor's Court Clerk and;

WHEREAS, The Mayor of Amelia Village, after conferring with the Police Chief, has recommended the hiring of Jennifer Diesel-Sloan to fill the role of full time position of Assistant to the Chief of Police/Mayor's Court Clerk for Amelia Village, and;

WHEREAS, The Council of Amelia Village concurs in the hiring of Jennifer Diesel-Sloan as full time Assistant to the Chief of Police/Mayor's Court Clerk for Amelia Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that;

SECTION I. Jennifer Diesel-Sloan is hereby hired as a as full time Assistant to the Chief of Police/Mayor's Court Clerk for Amelia Village, effective on May 7, 2018 at a starting salary of \$15.50 per hour.

SECTION II. This appointment is contingent upon Jennifer Diesel-Sloan passing any required pre-employment examinations and/or drug screenings.

SECTION III. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is that this will allow her to begin working in the new full time position without disruption to the Assistant to the Chief of Police/Mayor's Court Clerk of Amelia Village. Therefore, provided this emergency Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring two readings on two separate dates.

MS. RUMKE seconded the motion.
