INTRODUCTION

The report contains alcohol-related information collected in all twenty-three counties in the State of Wyoming for a period of twelve months (January 1 through December 31, 2018 by the Wyoming Association of Sheriffs and Chiefs of Police. Information was collected from a total of 12,366 persons who were arrested and subsequently detained in a county detention facility. It also includes statistics from 1,981 persons booked into the VOA Center of Hope in Fremont County.

This report provides detailed county specific alcohol-related information and is a supplement to the <u>Alcohol and Crime in Wyoming – 2018^1 report.</u>
