

Roy's Reflections

Well, if you want my opinion

"A fool finds no pleasure in understanding but delights in airing his own opinions." Proverbs 18:2

Does the above proverb make you feel a little uneasy? In a democratic country, a person usually cherishes freedom of speech and "airing his own opinions". It's even considered a strength, not a weakness, although this is sometimes a matter of self-justification.

The International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights adopted article 19 that was passed by the United Nations in 1948. It stated,

"everyone shall have the right to freedom of expression; this right shall include freedom to seek, receive and impart information and ideas of all kinds, regardless of frontiers, either orally, in writing or in print, in the form of art, or through any other media of his choice."

Lofty words. A later amendment states that this right carries "special duties and responsibilities" and must "therefore be subject to certain restrictions". What do you think prompted this later amendment? What a tangled web we weave when insisting upon personal rights.

The proverbs of Solomon do not deny our right to opinions. They do, however, repeatedly warn us not to "delight" in those opinions, even vaunting these opinions as facts. Solomon contrasts the fool's opinions to proper understanding. Perhaps one of the saddest things we see today is the stance of the narcissist, fundamentally abandoning understanding because it seldom provides immediate personal glory.

How do we attain understanding? It has been observed that God has given us two ears but only one mouth. The point? Start with the facts! In this same chapter in Proverbs we read:

"He who answers before listening—that is his folly and his shame." Proverbs 18:13

There comes a time to stand up and be counted. In James 1:19,20 we find the Christian's rule of thumb for sharing opinions:

"...be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, for man's anger does not bring about the righteous life that God desires."

So, our goal is not the grand announcement of another personal opinion, but "the righteous life that God desires."

We have a commitment, empowered by the Holy Spirit,

To give glory to God

To be unified in reaching others

To be living witnesses for Christ

May the Lord bless you and keep you. May the Lord make His face shine upon you and be gracious to you;
May the Lord turn his face toward you and give you His Peace.
(Numbers 6:24-26)
