Hunter Specifications

Hunter Pleasure Pony Open to all ponies ridden by juniors. May be combined with the Junior Hunter Pleasure and/or Adult Hunter Pleasure divisions. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going.

Junior Hunter Pleasure Open to all horses ridden by juniors. May be combined with the Pony Hunter Pleasure and/or Adult Hunter Pleasure divisions. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going.

Adult Hunter Pleasure Open to all horses ridden by adults. May be combined with the Pony Hunter Pleasure and/or Junior Hunter Pleasure divisions. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going.

Hopeful Hunter Open to all riders adults and juniors on horses or ponies. Fence height: 2.

Children's Hunter Open to junior riders mounted on horses. May be combined with

Adult Amateur Hunter division. Fence height 2'6"

Adult Amateur Hunter Open to amateur riders no longer eligible to show as juniors. May be combined with the Children's Hunter division. Fence height 2'6"

Green Hunter Open to horses of any age in their first or second year of showing in any classes that require horses to jump the height for green horses. May be combined with the Green Pony division. Fence height: Min of 2'6"

Working Hunter Open to horses and to ponies not entered in pony divisions.

Fence height: 3' (3'6" option at outdoor shows)

Green Pony Hunter Open to juniors on ponies. Ponies may be of any age in their first year of showing in any classes that require ponies to jump the designated height for green pony.

Ponies are only allowed to show 1 year as Green Ponies. May be combined with the Green

Horse division. Fence height: small 2', med 2'3, large 2'6"

Small / Medium / Large Pony Hunter Open to juniors mounted on ponies.

Large pony hunter. Fence height: small 2', medium 2'3 (Division maybe be split)

Pony Equitation Open to juniors mounted on ponies. A rider can only participate in one Associate Equitation Class per show, with the exception of the VHSA Equitation on the Flat Class.

VHSA Adult Amateur Equitation Class/ VHSA Children's Equitation Open to juniors mounted on horses or Open to Adult Amateurs mounted on horses. Shows are allowed to combine any of the three Equitation classes, however, the secretary must specify on the results sheet by each rider's name as to which class points should be applied to (i.e., Pony, Junior or Adult).

RIBBONS: Ribbons awarded through sixth place in all classes, Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons for all divisions.

\$75 Stake Classes (must have at least 5 in class for payout). Awards as follows:

First: \$25, Second: \$20, Third: \$15, Fourth: \$15

Stake money only awarded to classes with a minimum of five (5) entries.

Show Fees

Fox Chase Farm Show Rules and Regulations

- 1. All checks should be made out to "Equestrian Sports LLC"
- 2. Every class offered is governed by the current rules and specifications of the VHSA.
- 3. All riders **must** wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while mounted.
- 4. No Dogs Allowed
- 5. At every show, an Entry Form must be carefully read and signed by each rider/exhibitor (and his or her parent or legal guardian if under the age of 18) and other related Participants prior to participating in any activity or riding on Fox Chase Farm property.
- 6. Current negative coggins on all horses on the show grounds must be presented to show secretary.
- 7. Payment must be left with show secretary in office before numbers are given out.
- 8. Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries before or during the show without liability or compensation.
- 9. Show Management will not tolerate hostile or unsportsmanlike behavior. Show Management and Judge's decisions are final.

- 10. Fox Chase Farm is a private property open to the public for events. Anyone may be asked to leave, at any time, for any reason.
- 11. Fox Chase Farm, its members, managers, employees, agents, sponsors and affiliates, etc., are not responsible for damaged vehicles or other property and/or any lost or damaged items in vehicles or on the show grounds.
- 12. Items left on show grounds will be kept for a limited time before given away or thrown out. Please be sure to get all personal items before leaving shows.
- 13. To be eligible for all year-end prize money and awards, you must show at 80% of the Fox Chase Farm Hunter shows and be present at the Finals in the fall.
- 14. All riders/exhibitors (including parents and legal guardians if under the age of 18), owners, trainers, their agents and other related Participants will be held responsible for any damage to the Show grounds, jumps, rails/poles, and/or Fox Chase Farm or its affiliates' property.
- 15. No one or horse is allowed to walk the grounds outside of the show area. No one is allowed to touch resident horses or use their items or inside wash stalls. There is a designated area for visiting horses. Please ask Show Management.
- All classes can be moved, canceled, split or combined at the option of Show Management.
- 17. Judges listed in any program, website, email or anywhere, etc., is not a guarantee that they will be judge on said show days.
- 18. If any divisions or classes are combined, prize money will not be doubled.
- 19. Anyone disqualified may be found ineligible for ribbons, prizes or prize money.
- 20. Ribbons or prizes must be picked up at show office on show days or during the regular business farm hours, or by scheduling an appointment.
