ACTIVE SHOOTER SITUATION TIPS

The last Board meeting included an excellent presentation by the Sheriffs Department of how to react in an active shooter situation. Following are some tips from this presentation.

An active shooting situation is over in 2-5 minutes; generally before law enforcement can respond. In every situation we are in; work, volunteer activity, recreational activities, we should know where the exits are. It is important to formulate a plan quickly and act. Shooters are looking for easy targets. There are three choices: run, take cover or fight back with anything available to you. Do not pull the fire alarm; the noise provides cover for the shooter, and increases confusion.
