

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

TOWN OF KREMMLING  
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING  
January 4, 2017

The Board of Trustees, for the Town of Kremmling, met in the boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. Mayor Thomas Clark called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Trustees present: Scott Crandall, Gina Schroeder, Jason Wikberg, Wes Howell, Guy Bakke, and Grace Bohall. Staff present: Town Manager Mark Campbell, Police Chief Scott Spade and Town Clerk Rhonda Shearer. Trustee Bakke entered at 6:32 p.m.

HOWELL MOVED TO ACCEPT THE REGULAR PROCEEDINGS FOR DECEMBER 21, 2016. WIKBERG SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

SCHROEDER MOVED TO APPROVE THE EXPENDITURES FROM DECEMBER 22, 2016 THROUGH JANUARY 4, 2017 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$85,347.09. CRANDALL SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

CRANDALL MOVED TO APPROVE THE AGENDA. HOWELL SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

Scott Howell talked to the board and staff about snow plowing. He wanted to know if a plan was in place on how the plowing will take place. Manager Campbell explain the new snowplow route ordinance and what the higher priorities areas are, like main street.

The Mayor reported:

- The month of December was at 161% of average for the water month, and the first quarter ended at 98% of average.

The Police Chief reported:

- The new parking and snow route areas are working well so far, with only minor issues.
- The new police truck should be delivered next week.

- He will be attending the annual managers conference at the end of January in Glenwood Springs.
