THE BEST OF VERMONT, NEW HAMPSHIRE & MAINE

6 Days - 5 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1- Depart from Leesport and travel to Killington, VT. Upon arrival at your hotel (**North Star Inn**) you will enjoy a **welcome reception**. You will have time to freshen up before departing for dinner and an **evening of entertainment**.
- Day 2 Enjoy a full breakfast at the inn, then depart with your local guide for a day in Vermont. Your first stop will be the **Rock of Ages Granite Quarries & Manufacturing Plant** where you will look down into the world's largest working granite quarries and watch master craftsmen create the finest granite products. Stop at the Visitors Center and gift shop. After your visit, you will head for the **Trapp Family Lodge for a delicious luncheon** featuring a hot/cold buffet and Austrian pastries. Visit the lodge and gift shop and learn about the "Sound of Music" family. Afterwards, you will stop at the **Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream Factory for a tour**. Dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 3 After a full breakfast at the inn, check out and depart with your local guide for another day of touring. Your first stop today will be at **Sugarbush Farms**, an off-the-beaten path family farm where you will learn how they make their maple syrup and cheddar cheese. Sample the different grades of syrup and various cheeses. Continue to **Woodstock** where you will have lunch on your own in this quaint, charming village. Do some browsing and shopping and visit the **Covered Bridge**. Later, you will stop at the **Quechee Gorge**, Vermont's "Little Grand Canyon", for a photo opportunity. Your last stop will be a ride on the **Loon Mountain Gondola Ride**, the longest sky ride in New Hampshire. Bid farewell to your guide as you depart for Plymouth, NH. Upon arrival you will check into the **Common Man Inn**, a charming country inn where you will also enjoy a delicious dinner. Later in the evening you will depart on a **3-hour Pemi Valley Moose Tour** for an opportunity to spot and photograph moose.
- Day 4 This morning you will enjoy an extended continental breakfast before departing with your local guide for a day of touring in New Hampshire. Arrive at **Castle In The Clouds** for a self-guided tour of this famous 1914 mansion which features breathtaking views of New Hampshire's natural splendor ... Ossippee Mountain and Lake Winnipesaukee. Visit the gift shop before departing for lunch on your own at Wolfeboro. This afternoon you will have the option of visiting the **Moultonboro Country Store** or the **Loon Center**. Your day will end with the **Lake Winniepsaukee Scenic Railroad Ride** which includes a turkey dinner as it takes you along the shores of the lake.
- Day 5 Enjoy an extended continental breakfast, then check out and depart for Maine. Arrive in Kennebunkport to meet your local guide who will take on a **tour of Kennebunkport**. learn about this popular summer resort as you drive by the Bush Family's summer home and sea captains' mansions. After the tour, arrive at **Dock Square** in downtown Kennebunkport where you can have lunch on your own and free time to explore and shop in the area. Bid farewell to your guide as you depart for Portl and's Harbor to board the **Lighthouse Lovers Cruise**. This narrated 90-minute scenic cruise takes you through the busy harbor and innermost islands to see seven lighthouses, forts, lobster boats, seals, and seabirds. You will get an up-close view of four lighthouses, including Maine's oldest and most photographed lighthouse, **Portland Head Light**. After the cruise, check into the **Best Western Merry Manor Inn** in South Portland. A delicious **lobsterbake dinner** will end your day.
- Day 6 Following breakfast, check out and prepare for your departure home taking with you fabulous memories of your vacation in beautiful New England!
