1. Are there any parts of the Bible you do not believe?

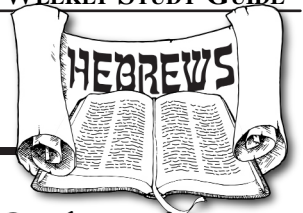
2. How do Jesus' words in JOHN 17:17 relate to the issue of whether the Bible is true?
