Revises the law for outdoor housing facilities for dogs

- Prohibits dogs from being outside and unattended with conditions that pose serious adverse risk to health and safety (exposed to elements for 15 minutes not in range of owner) except for livestock and farm dogs
- Requires shelter to be moisture proof and windproof with raised floor and made of durable materials with a windbreaker at entrance during Nov 1 Mar 1
- Bans metal doghouses
- Must be provided access to food and water
- Prohibits tethers from being attached to choke, pinch, prong, or martingale collar AND prevents tethering more than 2 hours when owner is not on property
- Bans wire only floors
- Considers tethering more than 9 hours a day to be cruelty except for farms
- Civil penalties of \$100 + costs for 1<sup>st</sup> violation, \$250 + cost for 2<sup>nd</sup>, and \$500 + costs per additional

Requires dogs to be leashed when outside except while on owner's property, private property with permission or inside a vehicle except for working dogs and at off-leash dog parks

- Animals tethered outdoors must be 1) protected from predators and be suited to tolerate such an environment, 2) not be out during hurricane or tropical storm warning, and 3) must not be out during a local or state heat advisory, when temperature is above 85 or less than 32 or during a severe weather warning unless animal control officer determines it to be safe
- Tethers must be 15' long or 4x length of animal except when attached to lead line unless animal control officers determines that a tether between 10-15' is safer

- Prohibits rental or leasing of dog or cat
- Prohibits covered person (pet shop, commercial dog breeder, pet dealer, firm, or other pet selling business) from offering agreement where dog or cat can be repossessed
- Prohibits financial institutions from offering loan for rental, lease or sale of dog or cat subject to repossession
- Violations are considered a prohibited practice regarding mispresenting goods or services and covered by that act AND business, retail or pet shop permit may be revoked after a hearing
- Exempts purebred dog under breeding contract, dogs or cats in spectator events, shows, exhibitions, motion pictures, or other entertainment and service, guide or leader, security, police or law-enforcement, military, and certified facility dogs

- Calls animal shelter holds for strays a stray hold period and requires their enclosures to have durable, nonporous, moisture impervious materials able to be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected and to provide the animal with adequate care and access to outdoor areas
- For animals not in stray hold period, requires 1) enclosure with adequate separation of animals of different species, sexes, ages, and temperaments with both an outdoor area not detrimental to the animal's health and an indoor area with a solid floor, and 2) adequate water, food and resting platform

- Removes provision making those entering dog in dog fight guilty of Class C felony
- Creates misdemeanor for devocalizing a dog or cropping its ear or tail except for veterinarian using accepted surgical procedures including for cutting off more than ½ ear of various livestock
- Adds exposing animal to excessive heat or cold to 1<sup>st</sup> degree animal cruelty, requires factoring in animal's breed, age, health and medical conditions to determine if it constitutes cruelty, and exempts unforeseen and unpreventable accidents and acts of nature
- Adds that those convicted of cruelty are also banned from caring for any animals
- Adds that knowingly and recklessly abandoning an animal used in fights does not have to cause bodily harm to the animal to be 2<sup>nd</sup> degree animal cruelty
- Allows person finding abandoned animal to take to animal care and control or rescue facility
