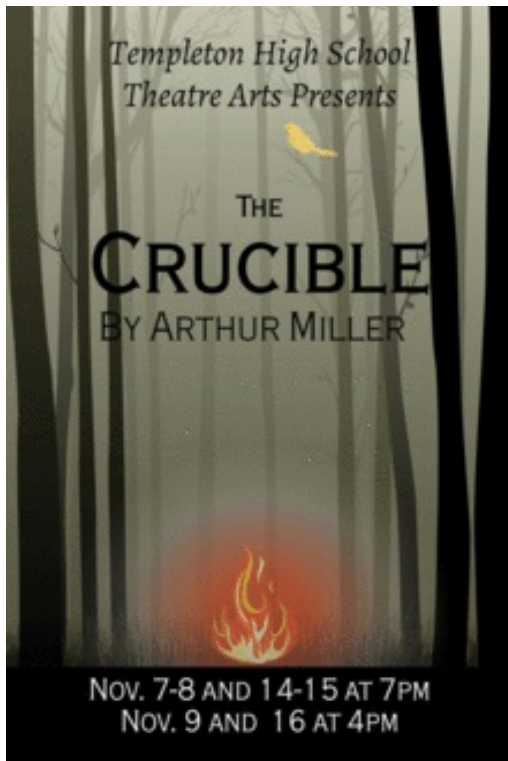
"The CRUCIBLE" by Arthur Miller

SPECIAL GUEST – Chris Barnickel, Director of San Luis Obispo County Libraries

Chris Barnickel will be on hand to provide information and answer questions regarding the progress and specifics of the proposed Library Bond Measure for the 2020 ballot and what is being considered on Templeton’s behalf. This is an opportunity to hear directly from the Director of SLO County Libraries regarding what the County is currently doing to help bring a library to Templeton. Community members are encouraged to attend and participate.

Editor’s Note! As many of you know, the County is considering a Library Bond Measure for the 2020 ballot. This meeting is an excellent opportunity to hear directly from the County Libraries Director about what is being discussed and how Templeton could benefit.

If a bond measure is placed on the November 2020 ballot and passes, as it currently stands, the County will pay for, build, and operate Templeton’s Library. This is an unprecedented opportunity. As those of you who have followed the news know, the Board of Supervisors voted unanimously in October to proceed with developing a Library Bond Measure. It is my understanding that the Board will most likely hear a progress report in the next few weeks and then take action on the item in the early spring.

At the moment, the preliminary work on the bond provides the funds to completely pay for the building of the original McCormick designed Templeton Library. Please consider attending the meeting to learn more and get your questions answered directly from the source. It is important to note that the library group is still sharply divided on which direction to take the project.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Excerpts from the SEPT 7 – UPDATE under the entry for the Mon, Sept 9 Library Board Meeting

Editor's Note! This is an extremely important meeting that may be a watershed moment for the library – pro or con. The board meeting will begin with a full agenda that includes an update on the County's participation in the library project that includes at least two more interesting, supportive developments at the County level. One of the potential decisions the board will make is whether or not the library group will move to put the original library plan – the plan under which the bulk of the fundraising to date was accomplished – on the back burner, and then implement the installation of a “Sprung” building to house the library instead. There is growing support for this change and those supporting it are moving forward very quickly, with the goal of putting the building up within the next few months. But the group supporting the change has not put forward a fully developed and vetted plan with a budget – let alone a sustainable budget for the maintenance and operation of the “Plan B” library – and there are a number of serious, unanswered questions.
