
CUT

- 1 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" A square, center block
- 2 3 1/2" x 2" B rectangles, background fabric
- 2 2 3/8" x 2 3/8" E squares, background fabric Cut these on the diagonal to make 4 triangles
- 2 2 3/8" x 2 3/8" D squares, spool fabric Cut on the diagonal to make 4 triangles
- 2 3 1/2" x 2" C rectangles, spool fabric



Completing the Spool Blocks

 Sew a D triangle to an E triangle to make a D-E unit as shown in Figure 1; press seam toward D.

2. To complete one Spool block, sew a D-E unit to opposite ends of C to make a C row as shown in Figure 2; press seams toward C. Repeat to make two C rows.

Sew B to two opposite sides of A to make the center row as shown in Figure 3; press seams toward B.

4. Sew a C row to opposite sides of the center row to complete one Spool block referring to the block drawing; press seams toward the center row.
