Parsonage Renovation Project

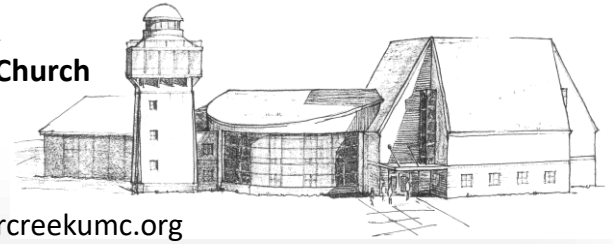
