- 🍏 Email was sent out with minutes from September 23, 2020 meeting. They were approved via email and posted to the township web site.
- 🍏 Gina W. called meeting to order 7:00 pm:
 - ✂️ Gina W., Rachel B., Bob B., and Jennifer W. present. Public: Deputy C. Hicks, Candidate for State Representative 100th District Sandy Clarke
- 🍏 Pledge of allegiance recited.
- 🍏 Sheriff Deputy C Hicks reported that Goodwell Township has been quiet. A few calls were discussed.
- 🍏 Candidate Sandy Clarke discussed who she is and what she has been involved in, and what she looks forward to working in if elected.
- 🍏 Rachel: **Treasurer's report** as of September 23, 2020:
 - ✂️ Have \$185,612.53 total.
 - ✂️ Payments were \$12,434.40: United States Treasury for taxes, for \$2,307.22 was largest bill.
 - ✂️ Revenue was \$5,020.82
 - ✂️ Bob motioned to accept and pay bills, Gina 2nd, roll call, passed
- 🍏 Bob: **Zoning report**:
 - ✂️ 1 Zoning app, 1 land division:
 - 🕒 Lanka – RV pole.
 - 🕒 Cristina Buff – 209 Newcosta parcel division, approved by county.
 - 🕒 New landowner questioning how to work easy access. Suggested working with property owner behind. Concern with another neighbor about fireworks, is there any ordinance? Shooting into a property could be trespassing. Bob is keeping eye on those neighbors to make sure their RVs are put behind their cabin.
 - 🕒 Retired state policeman bought property on Cottonwood. Checking on splitting property. Goodwell fine with splits, providing minimum of 5 acre per parcel, and easement observed.
 - 🕒 Fritz – a discussion about pole barns; specifically, agricultural vs. storage. Building department says storage needs a building permit, agricultural does not. Agricultural must have its primary use be storing hay/grain/farm equipment.
