This letter is to inform you that my Doctor, Dr. Robert Sauls has removed me from work on August 20/97. At that time I was encountering a great amount of back and neck pain due to the injury of Feb. 6/97. I requested to see my Doctor, as I felt that since I had returned to work the pain had gotten steadily worse to the point where I had found it difficult to concentrate on driving (80% of my work is driving). At this time my Doctor had removed from work and sent me back to physiotherapy at Physiotherapy One located at 2300 Eglinton ave. w. phone (905) 820-2829. I was then asked by my Doctor to return to him to be reassessed on August 29/97. When I seen my Doctor on August 29/97 he said I will remain off work as I have less mobility in my back. I am to see him again on September 12/97 at which time my Doctor will reassess my condition.


