Leaf Pickup

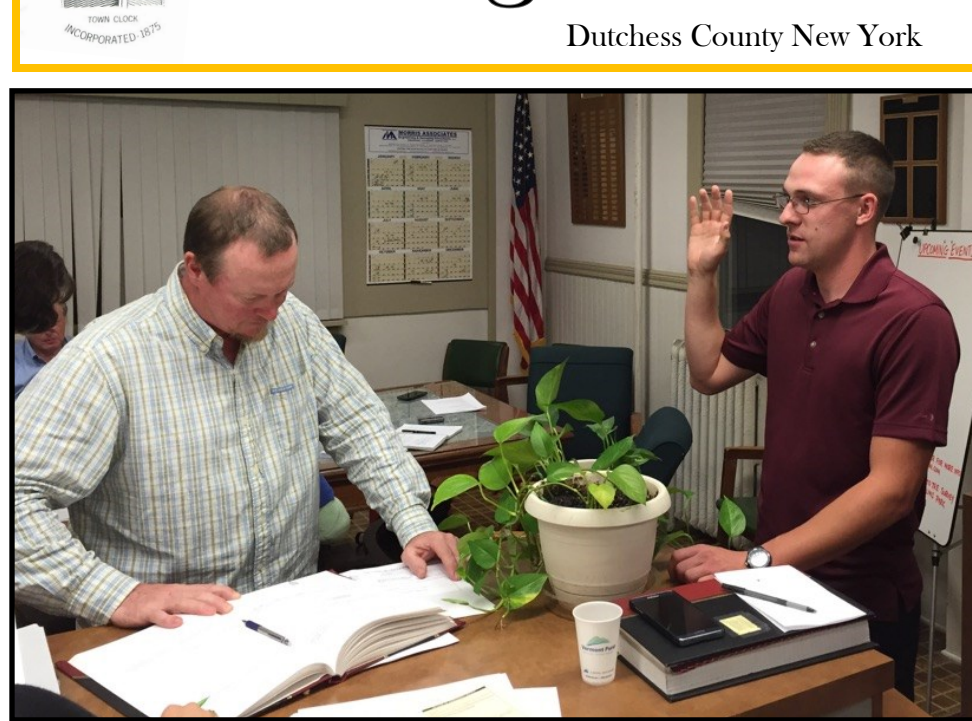
