Dear Friends in Christ,

Where did 2023 go? If you are like me, the days, weeks, and months seemed to fly by. And so, we find ourselves in a new calendar year. Christmas has come and gone. No snow on the ground somehow makes it seem like the New Year is here all too soon.

Back at the beginning of October when the war in Israel began, several of you had asked me if this was a sign of the end of the world. I even had a phone call or two asking how I was going to preach that the end was near. Well, those of you who came to worship regularly on Sunday mornings know that I did not preach such a sermon. And we are still here today at the dawning of 2024.

In Jesus' day the disciples wanted to know when the end would come, when Jesus would return. Matthew 24:3 "Tell us, when will this be, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?" is what they asked Him. Jesus responds that many things will have to take place first from wars, to earthquakes, to famines. After these things then the Son of Man will be seen coming on the clouds of heaven, and there will be a trumpet call. The disciples assumed that Christ would return again in their lifetime. 




