

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

MUST BE CLEAN AND DRY and NO FOOD

ITEMS THAT MAY BE RECYCLED:

Plastic Bottles/Containers Numbered #1 – 7

All plastic must have a number on it

Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs

Soft & Hard Cover Books

All Paper and Paper Bags

Paperboard (cereal/shoe boxes)

Milk/Juice Cartons

Glass Bottles/Jars

Aluminum (pie plates/trays/foil)

Metal Cans (tin/steel/aluminum)

Corrugated Cardboard:

CARDBOARD MUST BE DRY, NEAT, AND SECURED IN A BUNDLE.

NO LARGER THAN 40" LONG X 24" WIDE X 10" HIGH

EACH BUNDLE MUST HAVE A YELLOW STICKER (\$8)

STICKERS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE MONHEGAN STORE - \$8

ITEMS THAT **MAY NOT** BE RECYCLED:

No plastic bags of any kind

No plastic wrap, cellophane, shrink-wrap

No Recyclables Containing Food Waste

No Paper Towels, Napkins, Tissue Paper

No Styrofoam/ Foam Packaging

No Unmarked Plastics

No Window Glass/Mirrors/Light Bulbs

No Dishes, No Pyrex, No Ceramics

No Hazardous Material

No Trash, Furniture or Appliances

No Aerosol Cans

No Paper Towels, Napkins, tissue paper

No CLOTHING

***NO PLASTIC BAGS/WRAP of any kind
and NO FOOD***
