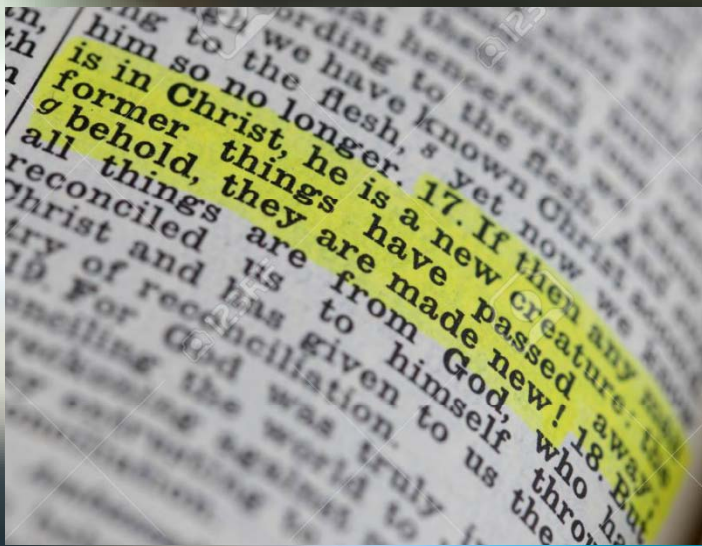
## Exodus 31:12-18 **Sabbath and The Lord's Day**

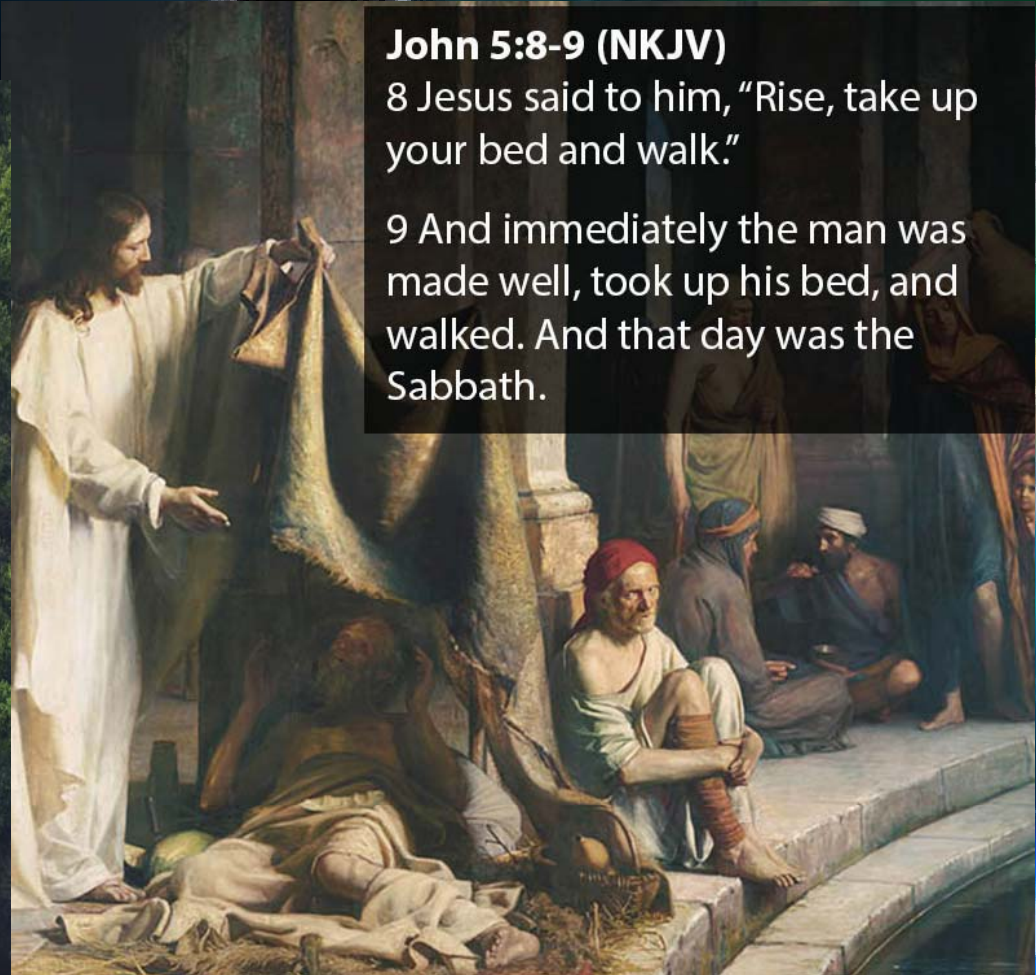

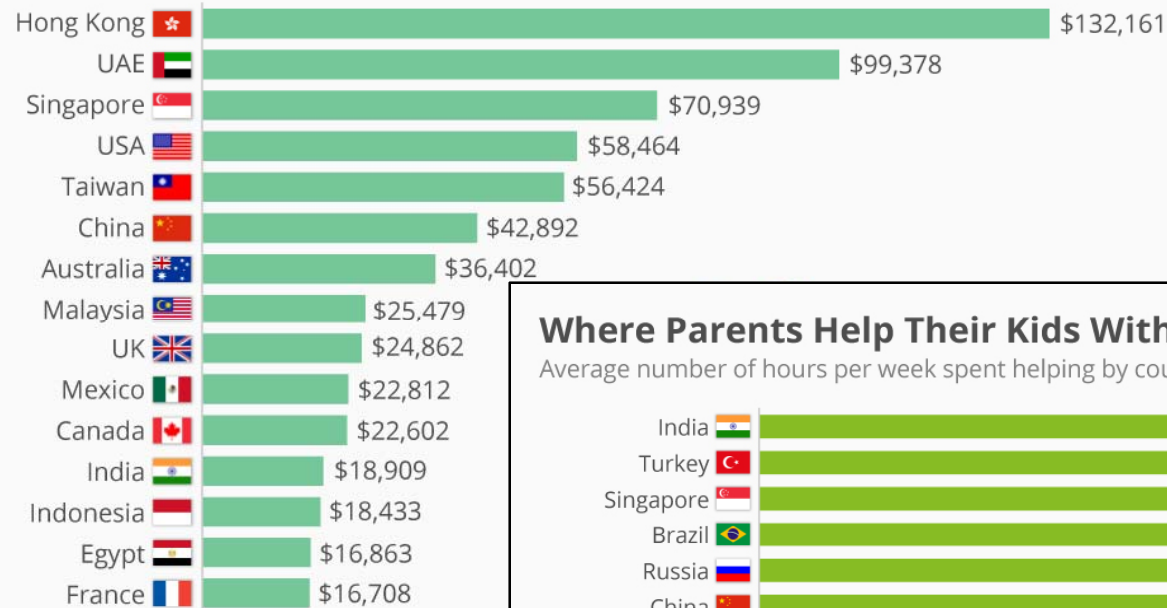

## Who Spends the Most on Their Child's Education?

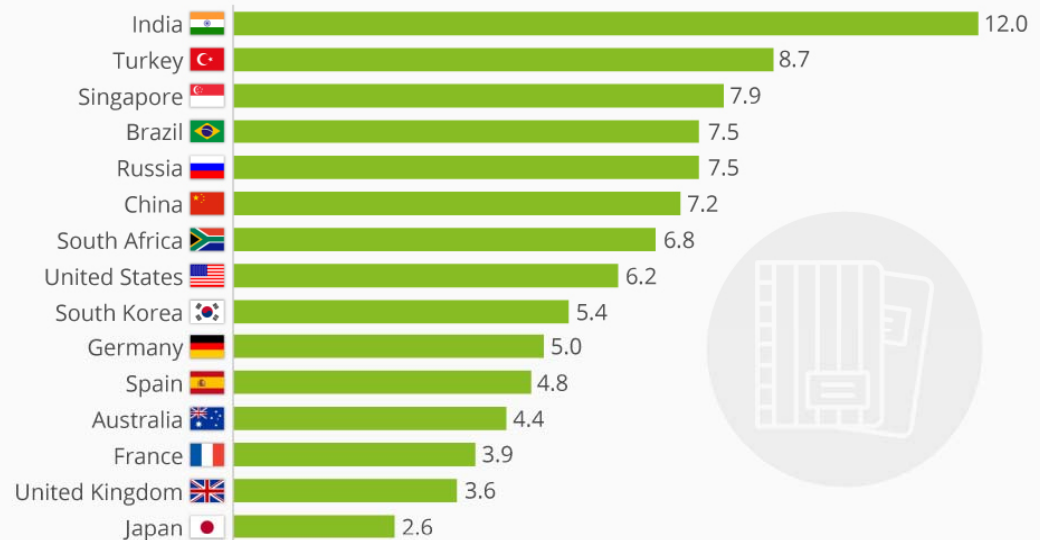
Average spend from primary school to undergraduate level
