Holiday Shop	Help children select holiday gifts for family and friends. (Early December days.)	
Mega Party	Supervise bounce houses during the day at this all-school event. (October day.)	
Reflections	Help organize student entries for the Reflections contest sponsored by the State PTA in the fall and assist with the award ceremony in the spring. (Fall, Spring.)	
STEM Fair	Help set up projects prior to the fair and/or judge projects by talking to the students during the fair. (Spring weekend.)	
TAG	Traveling Art Gallery shows a painting to classrooms, discusses the scene and artist. (Five 30-minute sessions scheduled at your convenience.)	
Yearbook	Help the yearbook staff by taking pictures at various events during the school year &/or building yearbook pages. You will need your own camera. (Ongoing, days.)
