All Systems 'Go' for 30th Annual Ride for Sight

It looks like NASA doesn't have a monopoly on 'All Systems Go' as conditions are in line for a return to 'normal' for the 30th edition of the Cheyenne Eye Clinic and Surgery Center/Cheyenne Sunrise Lions Club Ride for Sight on Sunday, Aug. 7.

The ride will follow the same format as a year ago with the event shifting to metric century (62 miles) and metric half-century (31 miles) distances although riders may opt to make their turn-around at any point they desire, but must start their return by 12 noon.

We will be following any COVID guidelines and recommendations which may be in place on the day of the event as set down by the City of Cheyenne and health entities of Laramie County and the State of Wyoming. Situations may well be fluid so please remain flexible as things may change right up to the date of the ride.

The event itself will feature the return of the popular free pasta dinner on Saturday evening and then Sunday things will open with a pre-packaged continental breakfast beginning at 6 a.m. followed by the start at 6:30 a.m.

Riders will find rest stops approximately every 10 miles featuring drinks, fruit, pre-packaged snacks, and energy foods plus toilet facilities. The event concludes with a post-ride lunch in addition to the awarding of various door prizes. What's more, don't worry about racing back for lunch as it will be available until the final rider has cleared the course. Even if you are running really late, we will package a meal for you!

The Ride for Sight is fully supported with sag wagons, roving mechanics, and HAM radio assistance. Nobody gets left on the course, either, as we carefully patrol the route at the end of the day and monitor every rider.

The Ride for Sight will also feature a complimentary T-shirt, water bottle, meal tickets, discount coupons and merchandise prizes! Plus, we'll have our great raffle topped by a \$1,000 store credit at Rock on Wheels as well as second and third place store credits of \$650 and \$350. 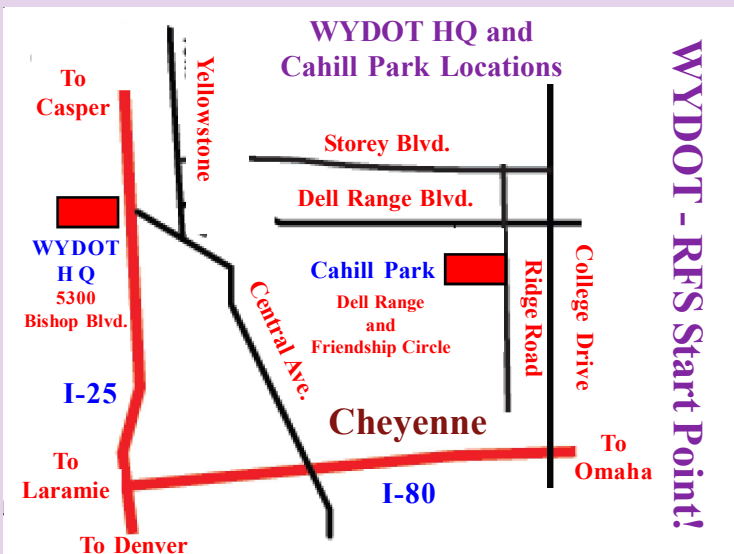
