

6. Impact to Resources – water, electricity, natural gas, space for trash disposal, air quality, carbon emissions, etc.

Current Fountain Valley residences and businesses are being constantly warned and told by officials there are not enough resources available and we all have to conserve, i.e. cut back, on their usage/consumption to avoid dire environmental and economic consequences.
