Thursday, March 13—Hotel check-in begins at 3:00 p.m. and Tour registration begins at 5:00 p.m. in the hotel meeting room. Join us for the catered "Welcome Party and Driver's Meeting," 6:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. in the meeting room.

Friday, March 14—Florida Southern College is home to the largest single-site collection of Frank Lloyd Wright architecture in the world and is a National Historic Landmark. Our first stop will be at the college, where we will enjoy a docent-lead tour of the Frank Lloyd Wright designed buildings on campus. Next, we'll head to Lake Mirror for a visit to Hollis Gardens, followed by lunch (*on your own*). Then, we'll drive the rural roads to the Florida Air Museum. The Museum features a display of aircraft including one-of-a-kind designs, classics, ultra-lights, antiques and warbirds. It is home to the SUN n FUN Aerospace Expo and Fly-In, every April. Finally, we'll attend Lakeland's cruise-in and car show, to show the locals what great cars Packards are.

Saturday, March 15—We'll stop for coffee at the historic 1928 Polk Theatre on our way to the Mac Fuller car collection in Winter Haven. Then, we're off to Bok Tower and Gardens in Lake Wales. We'll arrive at Bok in time to hear the singing tower's fabulous 30-minute Carillon concert, learn about the tower and tour the world-famous gardens. Bok Gardens is also home to the historic El Retiro Mansion and to the Blue Palmetto Café, our suggested lunch stop.

Sunday, March 16—Our third day of touring will include a scenic guided boat cruise on the waters of historic Winter Haven. Then we will cruise in the Packards to the lakefront home and garages of Dan and Roseann Gernatt. Dan has a wonderful collection of award-winning cars, and is a giant in the touring hobby. You never know which cars will be in Florida, but they will all be impressive. After that, we'll drive to another lakefront stop—Cherry Pocket Steak and Seafood Restaurant, not far from the Gernatts' place. Tour activities officially end on Sunday in the mid-afternoon.
