- Amazing team effort summarizes the Women's XC final weeks of the season. For the ECC
 meet in Milford, the women took 2nd place behind a very strong Turpin team. While Turpin
 took the team trophy, Kings had the individual champion and ECC Runner of the Year along
 with the 3rd place spot in the race.
- The following week was the district meet at VOA. The women's team just barely missed qualifying for the regional meet, yet the team ran exceptionally well against very tough competition from huge, competitive teams such as Mason. Kings still produced the overall 2nd place finisher in this race which qualified her for regionals.
- The next week at the regional meet, every runner in the race fought a tough, slow course on a windy day. Kings qualifier Hannah Rasmussen pulled down a 9th place finish and qualified for the state meet the following weekend, where Hannah ran strong and finished 65th overall.
- Overall, the season was a big success with Hannah, Leah Maschino and Jennifer Cooper each moving up the school record board, with Hannah taking the top slot. Leah and Jennifer will lead the team next year along with a really strong group of young runners. They look

forward to a great season in 2017.

HS Men's Cross Country – Dave Stubenrach

- The Gentlemen Knights Cross Country team claimed the ECC Crown this year with a dominating performance. It is the third title in the 5 year history of the ECC.
- The team took places 4th through 8th with sophomore Jacob Krynock leading the pack at 16:27. He was followed by juniors Isaac Onnen, Gideon Diebel, Robbie Winkler and Chris Stock.
- The following week at the Southwest Ohio District Meet, the pack of Stock, Winkler, Onnen & Krynock, along with senior Max Schowalter took places 14 to 18 and carried the team to a third place finish and a trip to the Troy Regional.
- At the Regional, a windy day slowed the men, and they finished in 10th, not enough to advance to State.
- Max Schowalter was the team's MVP, junior Nate Muenchen earned the Red, White & Blue award and Robbie Winkler most improved, cutting the most time from last year to this.
- The team loses 2 seniors from their top 10, so the team and coaches are looking forward to next fall already.
