



2021 YSA Fall Classic Rules

- 1) All matches with the exception of final matches will be played at reduced times. Match times will be as follows:
 - 8U – (2) 15 minute halves
 - 10U – (2) 20 minute halves
 - 12U – (2) 25 minute halves
 - 14U – (2) 20 minute halves

- 2) The tournament is a point system similar to the Soccer Spectacular. Each team is guaranteed 2 matches. The teams moving on to the finals or semi-finals will do so on a point system. Due to time constraints, matches ending in a tie will remain a tie in the point system. The point system for the Fall Classic is as follows:
 - Each win = 3 points
 - A tie = 2 points
 - A loss = 0 points
 - A forfeit = -1 points

- 3) The tiebreaker criteria is as follows:
 - 1) Head to head competition
 - 2) Bonus points accumulated (maximum of 3 per match)
 - 3) Least amount of goals allowed
 - 4) Shots from the mark.

- 4) Procedure for shots from the mark (PK Shootout)
 - Each team will designate 5 player to participate.
 - Players selected must have been on the field when time expired from the match.

- Each player will take a shot on the opposing teams goalie until all 5 players have taken a shot or a team has been mathematically eliminated from winning.
 - If the match is still tied after each team has had 5 players to take shots, each team will send players 1 by 1 to take shots until the tie is broken. Each team must take the same amount of shots during the tiebreaker process.
 - The goalie for each team must be the goalie who was playing that position at the end of match time.
 - No player may take more than 1 turn at taking a shot until both teams have exhausted all players.
- 5) Awards will be given to the champion and the finalist from each division and will be presented at the field of play at the end of the match. Please have players, parents, and coaches to remain at the field until the end of the awards ceremony to help abide by social distancing standards.
- 6) There will be absolutely no protest of any match or call by a referee allowed during the tournament.
- 7) The referee is responsible for turning in the match report to either Jason St. John or Jacob Trivette to have the brackets updated. The brackets will be posted at the black concession stand trailer for 7, 8, & 12U. Results for 9, 10, & 14U will be posted at the white concession trailer.

Please remember that all recreation tournaments for YSA are fundraisers in which there is a \$5 charge per car to enter.
