Eligibility: Entry is open to all juried members of the Buffalo Niagara Art Association. Annual membership fees must be paid. All two-dimensional artworks (maximum 2 per person) must be original. No copies or work executed in a supervised workshop or class are acceptable. No photography or prints allowed. Work must have been executed in the last three years and not previously exhibited in a BNAA show. Decision of the Screening Committee is final.

Conditions: As per national standards, artworks must be suitably framed, wired and ready to install. (No saw tooth hangers.) Mats must be white or off-white. Plexiglass is preferred; glass allowed on pieces up to 18" x 24" and for larger pastel works with appropriate heavier wire for hanging. **Incomplete entry forms are ineligible and will be returned to the artist. Title and price of work MUST MATCH information on the application form.** (Artists will be informed by phone of non-selected works. Non-selected works may be picked up Tuesday, November 5, not during the reception.)

Fee: \$30.00 for up to TWO pieces, payable to **Buffalo Niagara Art Association**. Entry forms must be *received* no later than Wednesday, September 9, 2020. Mail to: **Sherryl Perez, 3886 Slusaric Road, Wheatfield, NY 14120.**

Prizes: Cash and other awards.

Juror of Selection and Awards: GARY WOLFE – Gary earned undergraduate degrees in Christian Ministries from Houghton College and in Psychology from State University of New York at Buffalo. He then returned to complete a Master's Degree in Painting and Art History from the University of Buffalo. Gary is twice past-president of the Buffalo Society of Artists, as occasional adjunct instructor at Daemen College and has served as a board member and consultant to local arts organizations. His work has been shown in Chicago, Philadelphia, Houston, Ann Arbor, Buffalo, Rochester, and other cities in the Northwest, as well as in Canada. He continues to live and work in Western New York.

There is no Opening Reception. The gallery is currently open by appointment for small groups so viewing will be encouraged.

Sales: Sales are encouraged. The gallery charges a 30% commission for sales. No PORs accepted.
