DESCRIPTION: VERY RARE high-end hunting bow. This bow received rave reviews in a bow review done for Bow and Arrow magazine in the early 70's. Proline was another Michigan archery company (along with Root) that had built some bows for Shakespeare (primarily the Condor, Osprey, and Eaglet). Proline built recurves for Shakespeare during the 1960's through the mid 1970's. You can see Ernie Root's influence in the design. This Osprey is a great looking and performing recurve. It has been partially refinished. Phenolic and contrasting hardwood riser. Wide limbs. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips show their age but are in good condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches, nicks and blemishes here and there. Decals are a reproduction. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
