



Forgiveness

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt. 6:9-10) As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well-being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. (1 Tim. 2:1-2) In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2) As a fellow worker in Christ Jesus (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we lift up you and your entire house to the Father, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), , and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is

hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57)

In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven bless you and your house and keep you (Num. 6:24). Hear our cry, O God; attend to our prayer. From the end of the earth we will cry to You, when our hearts are overwhelmed; lead us to the rock that is higher than we are. (Ps. 61:1-2) Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Cor. 1:2) In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), High Priest over the house of God (Heb. 10:21), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will be slow to anger, abounding in mercy (Ps. 103-8), and quick to forgive (Luke 17:4), not letting the sun go down on your wrath (Eph. 4:26). When you are angry, in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your people will not sin. Instead, meditate within your heart on your bed, and be still. (Ps. 4:4) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your family will not resist an evil person. But whoever insults (slaps) you on your right cheek, let you turn the other to him also. (Matt. 5:39) Let you and your people reject a divisive man (Titus 3:10), that you and your family are not drawn into the snares of death (Prov. 14:27), receiving cursing and death into your lives (Deut. 30:19). According to the eternal purpose (Eph. 3:11), God grant that your understanding be mature (1 Cor. 14:20), that you and your people not deceive yourselves (1 John 1:8). Let you and your family not deny your sins (1 John 1-10); rather confess your sins, for He is faithful and just to forgive your sins and to cleanse you and your people from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). If another sins against you and your house, then let you and your family rebuke him, but if he repents, forgive him (Luke 17:3), up to seventy times seven (490 times) daily (Matt. 18:22) and reaffirm your love to him. (2 Cor. 2:8) For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you and your house. (Matt. 6:14) May the God of truth (Ps. 31:5, Deut. 32:4, Is. 65:16) keep you and your people from the snares they have laid for you, and from the traps of the workers of iniquity (Ps. 141:9-10). Let your minds not be poisoned by bitterness and bound by iniquity (Acts 8:23). in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your people pursue peace with all men, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord: looking diligently lest anyone fall

short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled; lest there be any fornicator or profane person like Esau, who for one morsel of food sold his birthright. (Heb. 12:14-16) According to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) **we** pray God will open your eyes and turn you and your family from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that you may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Jesus. (Acts 26:18) May you and your people cast away from you all the transgressions which you have committed, and get yourselves a new heart and new spirit. (Ezk.18:31) In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we petition the Lord to take the stony heart out of your flesh, and give you and your people a new heart of flesh (Ezk..11:19), so that out of the good treasure of your heart you will bring forth good things (Matt. 12:35), and by your words you and yours will be justified (Matt. 12:37). Let you and your house draw near to the Lord, your God, and honor Him with your heart and not just with your mouth and your lips. (Matt. 15:8) Thanks be to God who always leads you in triumph in **Christ**. (2 Cor. 2:14) Let us rejoice in the Lord, and glory in the Holy One of Israel. (Is. 41:16) The Lord, He has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, measured heaven with a span and calculated the dust of the earth in a measure; weighed the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance. (Is. 40:12) Let us give glory to the Lord, and declare His praise. (Is. 42:12)

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who is full of grace and truth (John 1:14), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will speak evil of no one, be peaceable, gentle, showing all humility to all men. (Titus 3:2) Surely the kindness (Eph. 2:7) of the great love (Eph. 2:4) of God your Savior (Eph. 4:5) will keep you and yours from being foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating others. (Titus 3:3) Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you and your house, with all malice (Eph. 4:31); in malice let you and your people not be babes, but in understanding be mature. (1 Cor. 14:20) Let you and your family be kind to others, tenderhearted, forgiving them, just as God for **Christ's** sake also has forgiven you. (Eph. 4:32) Let you and yours put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, and filthy language out of your mouth. (Col. 3:8) You and your people shall put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts,

and be renewed in the spirit of your minds (Eph. 4:22-23). Through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, whom God poured out on you and your people abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior (Titus 3:5-6), laying aside all malice, all guile, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, as newborn babes, desiring the pure milk of the word, that you and your house may grow thereby. (1 Pet. 2:1-2) Whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy let you and your family meditate on these things. (Phil. 4:8) Let you and your people repent of wickedness, and in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray to God that the unforgiving thoughts of your hearts may be forgiven you. (Acts 8:22) May the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ increase your faith (Luke 17:5), that you and your people shall forgive those who sin against you and your house when they repent (Luke 17:3-5). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God, may give you and yours a forgiving heart that you will love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, that you might be the sons and daughters of your Father in heaven. (Matt. 5:44-45) Being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made you and your family alive together with Him, having forgiven you and your people all trespasses, having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against you and your house, which was contrary to you. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. (Col. 2:13-14) For Jesus Christ, having disarmed principalities and powers, made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it. (Col. 2:15) In all these things you and your family are more than conquerors through Jesus Christ who loves you and your house. (Rom 8:37) The Lord, our God, He shall gather all nations and tongues; and we shall come and see His glory. (Is. 66:18) The Lord lives; in truth, in judgment, and in righteousness; the nations shall bless themselves in Him, and in Him they shall glory. (Jer. 4:2) The Lord, our God, He exercises loving-kindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth, for in these He delights. (Jer. 9:24)

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), merciful and faithful High Priest (Heb. 2:17), may the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the patience of Christ (2 Thess. 3:5). Let your love be without hypocrisy, and may

you and your house abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good (Rom. 12:9), building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keeping yourselves in the love of God (Jude 1:20-21). And whenever you or yours stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, let you forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses (Mark 11:25). Let you and your family judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. Give, and it will be given to you and your house: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you and your people use, it will be measured back to you and your house. (Luke 6:37-38) And whoever compels you and your family to go one mile, let you and your people go with him two (Matt. 5:41), always bearing with others in love (Eph. 4:2). Remembering always that we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. (Eph. 6:12) Let it be your choice to receive blessing and not cursing in every situation for it is written "I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live" (Deut. 30:19). Let you and all of your people choose life and stand against the wiles of the devil (Eph. 6:11). To Him, Jesus Christ, was given dominion and glory and a kingdom that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. (Dan. 7:14)

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Just One (Acts 3:14, 7:52), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday. (Ps. 37:5-6) Let you and your family keep your mind on the Lord and trust in Him; and the Lord will keep you and your people in perfect peace. (Is. 26:3) Surely, He has borne your griefs and carried your sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for your transgressions, He was bruised for your iniquities; the chastisement for your peace was upon Him, and by His stripes you are healed. (Is. 53:4-5) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that our Father and God will pull down the strongholds (2 Cor. 10:4) of anger,

resentment, bitterness (Eph. 4:31), hatred (Gal. 5:20) and un-forgiveness (Matt. 6:15). That by the power of the Holy Spirit He will break through every barrier (2 Cor. 10:4), heal every hurt (Is. 61:1), every wound (Jer. 30:17) and give you and your people eyes to see clearly (Matt. 7:5). In ***Christ*** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the Lord will not deliver you and your house to the torturers (Matt. 18:34), but instead give you and yours a heart of compassion that you might forgive the debt of others (Matt. 18:27). Let you and all of your people receive the Holy Spirit that you may forgive the sins of others and not retain them. (John 20:22-23) Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done. (Matt. 6:9-10) May our Father forgive you and your family your sins, just as you and your people forgive those who sinned against you and your house. And may God not lead you and yours into temptation, but deliver you and your people from the evil one. For His is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. (Matt. 6:12-15) Let us hear, and let us take it to heart, to give glory to His name. (Mal. 2:2) For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works. (Matt. 16:27)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), ***Jesus Christ***, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in ***Christ***, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that ***Christ*** might make known to you

the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord **Jesus Christ**. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and **Christ** will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards you and your house are thoughts of peace, to give you a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11), we ask our Father in heaven in the name of our Lord **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead (1 Pet. 4:5), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14), petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9) for it is written "Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession." (Ps. 2:8). The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12) and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it. (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34) "Who among you fears the Lord? Who obeys the voice of His Servant? Who walks in darkness and has no light? Let him trust in the name of the Lord and rely upon our God. (Is. 50:10) In **Jesus'** name (John 16:23) so be it. You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations. (Ps. 102:12) For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
