- 4. ... Belittle the Better or Weaker Players.
- In Anger, Throw Their Darts, Chalk, or The Eraser, Punch or Kick The Wall.

A Respected Darter Does ...

- 1. ... Utilize Good Sportsmanship and Commonsense.
- 2. ... Shake Hands Before and After A Match.
- ...Express and Convey The Act of "Courtesy" Towards The Opposing Team and Players.
- 4. ... Be On Time For A Match and On Time To The Hockey.
- 5. ...Is Reasonable and Not Demanding.
