## STUDENTS VISITNG NEXT GRADE CLASSROOM

Do students use cubbies? What time is lunch? Where are papers turned-in? These questions are just some of the questions students face as they prepare for next year. To answer these questions, students are visiting their classrooms for next year on Thursday, May $25^{\text {th }}$ from 12:45-1:15 p.m. They will visit with teachers, learn about what to expect, and have opportunities to ask questions. Though this year is not quite completed, the hope is these visits will answer questions and calm some nerves for next year.

## WATER DAY NEXT THURSDAY FOR K-2 ${ }^{\text {ND }}$ GRADES

On Thursday, May $18^{\text {th }}$, water balloons, water slides, and water games will fill the playground, as the $K-2^{\text {nd }}$ graders participate in the annual Water Day event. (Note - The $3^{\text {rd }}-8^{\text {th }}$ graders will be off-campus at Wet-n-Wild Water Park.) A tentative schedule for the day includes:

Students need to come to school in their purple t-shirts and khaki or blue jean shorts, but may wear their swimming suits under their clothes or bring along their swimming suits and change before the activities begin. Students also need to bring a towel and sunscreen, plus a water bottle and cap/visor. For lunch students will be served a grilled hot dog lunch, which will be free to everyone.

## WET-N-WILD FIELD TRIP NEXT THURSDAY FOR $3^{\text {RD }}-8^{\text {TH }}$ GRADERS

On Thursday May $18^{\text {th }}$, the $3^{\text {rd }}-8^{\text {th }}$ graders will spend the day having fun at Wet-n-Wild Water Park located at $43^{\text {rd }}$ Avenue and Pinnacle Peak Road. The park opens early in the year just for school groups. All parents are invited to join the $3^{\text {rd }}-88^{\text {th }}$ grade students and teachers for this day of fun in the sun! (Note - Younger and older siblings may not attend.)

Students need to wear school uniform, but may wear their swimming suits under their clothing.
Students may also wear flip flops to school instead of shoes adhering to the uniform policy.
Parents are asked to review the following rules with their children to ensure everyone understands the expected guidelines:

1. Wristbands will be handed out the morning of the field trip and must be worn all day.
2. Individuals may not take food or beverage into the park except unopened, factory-sealed water bottles. Backpacks, purses, and all other bags will be searched before entering the park.
3. Students need to bring a towel and sunscreen. Students will apply sunscreen throughout the day unless they bring a note from home. Students may bring a cap/visor and/or shirt to wear later in the day.

4. Students may wish to bring money to purchase items from the Snack Shop or rent tubes for the slides, but this is optional.
5. All other personal items, including cell phones, i-Pods, and handheld video games, are to be left in the School Office or at home.
6. Students are to check-in at the SSA camp area three times during the day: (1) upon arriving and applying sunscreen, (2) before going to lunch and reapplying sunscreen, and (3) departure time.
7. Students are to have a buddy throughout the day. The buddy may be a classmate, friend from another class, or SSA adult. Buddies may change during the day.
8. Lunch will be eaten as an SSA group at the designated time. The menu is hamburger, chips, and drink.
9. All items, such as backpacks and towels, may remain at the SSA camp area, but SSA and Wet-n-Wild are not responsible for lost or missing items.
