Mr. Vincoli:

You are correct that on September 13, 2012, I provided you with the attached letter stating that the State Bureau of Investigation (SBI) had not conducted any investigation into allegations regarding Baptist Hospital and the State Health Plan. Subsequent to my letter of September 13, the SBI received a request from Forsyth County District Attorney Jim O'Neill to review this matter. Pursuant to Mr. O'Neill's request, the SBI conducted a preliminary inquiry into the allegations. The results of the preliminary inquiry were communicated to Mr. O'Neill via a memorandum from Agent Scott Williams on October 12, 2012. It is my understanding that you received a copy of that memorandum from Mr. O'Neill via e-mail on October 23, 2012. That memorandum is the only record of any inquiry or investigation performed by the SBI into these allegations.

I have checked with our Professional Standards Division and we have no record of receiving a State Property Incident Form from anyone at DPS regarding the Baptist Hospital/State Health Plan allegations. If I can be of further assistance, please let me know.
