ITINERARY

OCT 25 (Wed): DEPART USA
Depart from the USA for a transatlantic flight to Athens.

OCT 26 (Thu): ARRIVAL ATHENS
Arrive in Athens. Transfer to your hotel on your own. Rest of the day free or exploring on your own.

OCT 27 (Fri): ATHENS - EMBARKATION
Drive to port and embark your cruise ship, enjoying the fellowship of other Christians and excellent teaching.

OCT 28 (Sat): THESSALONIKI
Paul (with Silas and Timothy) came to Thessalonica from Philippi on his second missionary journey. Visit the Walls, The House of Jason where Paul lived and the Agora where he preached.

OCT 29 (Sun): KAVALA - PHILIPPI
Kavala (ancient Neapolis), the site where Paul, Timothy and Silas landed on the coast of Thrace. From there, visit Philippi where Paul lived, preached and was imprisoned and the Baptistery of Lydia, where the first baptism on European soil took place.



OCT 30 (Mon): ISTANBUL
In the morning we arrive in Istanbul, one of the world's greatest historic cities. Formerly Byzantium, the center of the Eastern Roman Empire, this city is built on seven green hills and situated astride two continents. East meets West in every way. Tours today are optional at additional cost. We can visit the Topkapi Palace with its harem and fabulous treasure chambers, the Sultan Ahmed (Blue) Mosque with its six minarets, and St. Sofia, converted to a mosque from a Christian basilica after the fall of Constantinople in 1453.

OCT 31 (Tue): DIKILI - PERGAMON
A tour from Dikili (our port) is to the great city of Pergamon and a city of the Book of Revelation. Here was the infamous throne of Satan which John the apostle



referred to. Pergamon is one of the best-preserved ancient sites in Turkey.

NOV 1 (Wed): KUSADASI - EPHEBUS - MILETUS

Arrive at Kusadasi. Visit Ephesus, the most impressive archeological site in Turkey, including the Great Amphitheater where Paul spoke to the Ephesians. An afternoon tour to Miletus, where Paul delivered his touching farewell address to the elders of Ephesus and predicted his death, for those wishing to visit the place.

NOV 2 (Thu): PATMOS
Patmos, the "Holy Island" for the Christian faith. This is where the apocalyptic Revelation of John was written during his exile from the Roman Empire. We visit the cave and the monastery of St. John.



NOV 3 (Fri): DISEMBARK - CORINTH / ATHENS
Disembark the cruise ship. We visit the ruins of ancient Corinth where Paul worked. See the remains of first-



century shops, the agora where Paul was on trial at the Bema, the Fountain of Peirene, Temple of Apollo and visit the museum. Drive to central Athens and begin a tour of classical Athens. Among other masterpieces of the "Golden Age," we visit the Acropolis, the agora and the Mars Hill where Paul taught. our hotel for overnight in Athens.

NOV 4 (Sat): GREECE—USA
Group transfer to the airport for departure to the USA.

ROME EXTENSION OPTION

NOV 4 Sat: ATHENS / IMPERIAL ROME
Fly from Athens to Rome. On arrival you will discover Christian Rome. Discover the Vatican Museum for many of the world's masterpieces. In the Sistine Chapel, view Michelangelo's frescoes, which have been restored to their full, colorful glory. Tour St. Peter's Basilica where Michelangelo's "Pieta" -- the only work signed by the master -- will be just one of many highlights. Travel the famous Apian Way. Walk through the Catacombs of San Sebastiano. Visit Tre Fontane, where Apostle Paul was beheaded. Walk through Via Del Corso, Piazza de Spagna, and enjoy the Trevi Fountain, Pantheon and Piazza Navona.



**Note: some itinerary sites may be moved to Nov 5 depending on arrival time of air flight from Athens.*

NOV 5 (Sun): CHRISTIAN ROME
Experience the glory of Imperial Rome when you visit the Coliseum, famous as a place of spectacle and death. See the Circus Maximus, Nero's huge stadium was able to seat 250,000 for chariot races. See the Roman Forum, an ancient meeting place, market place, religious and political center. View the Arch of Titus commemorating Titus' conquest of Judea. You'll visit the Mamertina Prison, where it is believed that both Peter and Paul were imprisoned.

NOV 6 (Mon): LEISURE DAY—ROME

NOV 7 (Tue): ROME—USA
Group transfer to the airport for departure to the USA.
