Copies of September meeting minutes had been distributed via email for review. A motion made to accept meeting minutes was made by D Ruga. Second by T Pietrosante. All in favor.

Treasurer's Report:

Copies of banking statements and list of bills to be paid out were distributed to all attending members.

Checking balance: \$12,902.29

Savings: \$51,548.32

Total of bills to be paid out: \$14,710.30

Leaving a total in checking after bills pay of \$4,327.99***(\$6,136.00 payment will be held until

the check from Weymouth Twp. is received.)

There was discussion on various bills that were clarified as listed below:
